Minutes - May 10, 2023

<u>Call to Order:</u> Chairperson, Michael Luebke, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

<u>Business:</u>

- 1. Continue to Review Town of Brazeau Short Term Rental Ordinance Proposal:
 - Chairperson Luebke had distributed 9 questions of issues to resolve on proposed ordinances
 prior to recommendation to the town board. Plan Commissioners in favor of the Town of
 Brazeau proposed ordinance was: Grosse, Luebke, Kasten, and Rock. Gilligan was not in
 favor. Results of meeting of April 11, 2023 disclosed audience seemed in favor of proposed
 ordinance.
 - In reference of Town of Riverview application initial and renewal charge, no fee was recommended. The plan commissioners did speak with Steve and Sandy Fenn in the audience. Fenn's have only acquaintances (word of mouth) utilize their home and the Fenn's have a sales tax permit, state Waupaca County (corrected 6-7-2023) required permit and execute an annual inspection and water test.
 - Capacity of rental and length of stay was challenged and clarified via Wisconsin Towns
 Association legal opinion and Wisconsin state statute.
 - Use of accommodation tax (70%/30%) and waste disposal was openly discussed.
 - Next steps: revisit with Jayme Sellen of OCEDC and visit Town of Riverview old and new board members and officials regarding short term rentals.
 - Chairperson Luebke with redraft proposed ordinance based on plan commissioners' recommendations and comments.
 - Board Supervisor Parmentier commented individuals which own or have utilized rentals should abstain in the voting process.
