ORDINANCE NO: BZ #5-2016

Ordinance Related to Parking Restriction on Town Road

WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of Brazeau, Oconto County, Wisconsin, (hereinafter called the "Town Board") does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Parking Prohibited. The operator of any vehicle shall not park such vehicle, nor permit vehicle to remain standing at any time at the hereafter listed area:

N. Marl Lake Road, as posted no parking

Section 2. Parking Exception. Parking prohibited except temporarily for the purposes of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading or in receiving or discharging passengers or property and while the vehicle is attended by a licensed operator so that it may be moved promptly in case of an emergency and to avoid obstruction of traffic. All emergency vehicles exempt from prohibited parking.


Section 3. Penalty. Any person who violates section 1 or 2 of this ordinance shall forfeit not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$250.00 dollars. Each day, or partial day, of continued violation shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, without limiting the authority of the Town Board to impose the forfeiture, the Town Board may cause a vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance to be towed.

Section 4. Severability Clause. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part or provision of any section, clause, or provision hereof is invalid or if to any person or circumstance is invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions which can be given effect without the invalid provision.


Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and notice/publication by law.
