Fire Department: Fire Chief Fetterly reported they had a shed fire, auto accident and a joint call with Pound Fire Dept. at Patz Pallet. Brazeau Fire Dept. had repair work on rescue truck transmission. Dive Team: Brandon Pendl, Co-Captain, reported dive has training scheduled for May 21, 2016. Dive Team will be a presenter at the Sportsman Alliance meeting this month. Team viewed 1989 truck-Kimberly Fire Department; price tag \$35,000.00; no action.

Motion-Kempka/Second-Thomson to approve ordinance BZ #5-2016 Related to Parking Restriction on Town Road. Roll Call Vote: Yes-Kempka, Thomson, Wendt. No-none. Motion carried. John Rosner-16.5 feet-Rost Lake-Discontinuance Consideration: Jeffrey Lieuwin/Rob Kamps Land Surveying and Soil Testing presented the board with a mapping of 16.5 road location and high water marking-Rost Lake area relating to lot 5 & 6. Board was informed, Robert Rosenberger, DNR NR Basin Supervisor, identified the Ordinary High Water Mark elevation at 95.8'. Jeff Lieuwin and John Rosner responded to board questions and next steps to be executed. Motion-Thomson/Second-Kempka to table. Voice Vote: Yes-Thomson, Kempka, Wendt. No-none. Motion carried.

Considered changes: "beginning at Lost Lake Area Road replacing beginning at Tank Lane"; and grantor retains the right to terminate agreement at any time; and, bond amount set at \$5,000.00.

Purchasing Funds coming from Fire Department Donation Account. Possible selling price of existing trailer: \$500. Motion-Thomson/Second-Kempka approving purchase with quoted price and terms.
