<u>Fire Department:</u> Fire Chief Fetterly reported they had a shed fire, auto accident and a joint call with Pound Fire Dept. at Patz Pallet. Brazeau Fire Dept. recently completed a fire audit with positive feedback. Several probationary and new members attending firefighter training at NWTC.

<u>Dive Team:</u> Brandon Pendl, Co-Captain, reported dive training Feb. 27 executed by Green Bay Scuba ay and an ice dive class conducted at Kelly Lake on March 11-12. Dive team working on equipment servicing.
