Brazeau Fire: Fire Chief, John Fetterly reported department had lift assist and traffic assistance type calls.

Department working on position titles and responsibilities. Elections will occur in January 2019; current fire chief not rerunning.

<u>Dive Team</u>: Fire Chief, John Fetterly reported on behalf of Dive Team. Dive Team had a call on Rost Lake relating to lost dog. Dive Rescue unit with decal wrap being looked at by Rod Marquardt.

Highway Report: T. Grosse reported have received guaranteed seasonal fill salt shipment, usually taken in April of new year. Department will be acquiring sand to mix with salt. Hose replaced on IHC 2006.

<u>Public Comments:</u> Pam Duddek inquired as to why she was not on agenda and questioned \$25 refund for hall usage.
