Use scoop stretcher for hip injuries.

Naloxone Leave Behind Program: A vote was taken by a show of hands and it was determined that we will not be doing this program.

Wausau Trauma Training: NTCT in Wausau is having a trauma training on April 7, 2022. They will also have it on line. Anyone that wants to go can.
