Amendment to Ordinance 3.0300
Regulate Stopping, Standing, or Parking of Vehicles

3.0302 Purpose:

To regulate of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town roads in the Town of Brazeau as follows:

- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles is prohibited on:
 - 1. Lee Lake Public Access Road between no parking signs
 - 2. N Marl Lake Road
 - 3. All town roads between December 1st and April 15th
 - 4. All town roads can not be used for overnight parking or camping
- B. The Town Chairperson, or his or her designee shall ensure that appropriate traffic signs on the roads listed in section 3.0302(A) are present.
- C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the roads listed in section 3.0302(A) in violation of the above noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$50.00. Refer to the Town of Brazeau Fee Schedule.

All existing town ordinances, parts of ordinances, and amendments thereto in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

This ordinance is effective on 7-24-24. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
