Radio communications - There are many challenges with the radios currently and people not able to hear all the people responding. Remember to make sure when you radio in you get a confirmation from dispatch, it may take a few times. For Marinette, you should not change over from Oconto South channel until you hear someone say "full crew."

If you are on schedule you are expected to go on the call. If someone else responds it is most likely because they did not hear you. You should go to the scene and the person not on the schedule will return home.

Make sure you check your radios, not using them often and the humidity can cause problems. John K. can walk you through the steps to check your radios.
