Financial

The written financial report was presented by Clerk Andrist. General Fund balance as of February 17th, 2026 was \$839,373.37. Donation Fund Savings \$481.46; Fire Department, Ambulance and Dive Account Funds are \$165,793.71 bringing a total town balance to \$1,005,167.08.

John Fetterly presented the fire department report. John stated they had 8 calls. Had CPR/breathing training which he passed. All trucks are scheduled to get inspections done. BayCom has sale on pagers, and the Fire Department can get a good discount if they purchase them. There were 38 fire extinguishers serviced by Superior Fire Pros new company as North woods the old company could not do it in a timely matter.

Highway

Pete Schwenke typed up the highway report, and was read by Clerk Andrist. The Hwy department was able to get some brush cutting done by Peshtigo Brook area. First part of the month was pretty quiet. Plowed for a couple of snowfalls including the last major blizzard that took almost a week to clean up. There were a couple minor breakdowns from the blizzard that they were able to fix already and are reset for the next couple of snow events. Also, we were able to finish burning brush at the Leaf and Brush site.
