Service Director Update and Report

Schedule Discussion: Call volume is down slightly from last year's numbers. Vacations: please be aware of upcoming volunteer time off and fill in when you can. We are currently around 90% of a full schedule – great job to all.

Clothing: Orders for new t-shirts are being taken, options include the following: long sleeve, short sleeve, original back logo, new back logo, color, and if you would like your name on the sleeve. Nancy will be embroidering Brazeau Ambulance and the Star of Life on the front on the shirts and applying logos on the back. Once all members have received their first shirt, additional orders will be filled.

Community Letter Update: Donations to date total close to \$15,600, many have sent notes of appreciation, and we have had a few sparks of interest in volunteering.

Bagley/Beaver Board Meetings: Dennis will be attending the Town Meetings for Bagley and Beaver to introduce himself and to answer any questions they may have regarding the Ambulance Service.

Release of Liability for Treatment and/or Transportation Form: There is a new "Refusal" form that was duplicated from Shawano Ambulance, it is easier to fill out and will eventually be a duplicate print so we will be able to give one to the patient. Reminder to TAKE VITALS.

Ambulance 8081 Repairs: 8081 has been returned and is running as expected

New Cameras for Town of Brazeau Buildings: Five cameras have been installed, two on each end of the building to cover the front and side views and one inside in the mezzanine viewing the stairs and vehicles.

LOSA Plan Termination Update: Dennis is working on this with Melissa and will supply more information when available.

WEMSA Service Director Training Update: Dennis talked about the training take-a-ways from his class. One important point was that patient satisfaction was highest based on personal interaction over response time and treatment.

Cross Credentialing: Gage informed the group about what Cross Credentialing is and what steps need to be taken to be credentialed for both services Coleman and Brazeau and what the coverage would look like. If interested, please reach out to Gage and Dennis.

Paramedic Intercepts: Verifying that intercepts are to be called for every PNB call, you can call while in route to the call, the earlier the better

Other Business

Gage: There is a Blood Verification Class that he will share with us. Paramedics now can carry blood, and this is a training to be able to verify the blood going to be given, much like we verify the medication we are going to give to a patient between the medical personnel in the ambulance.
